



Residency Requirements

We bring the dances, the music, some great games and the set; however, please take a moment to organize the following before our arrival and for the duration of the program.

1. A clean gym floor

For students' safety and ours, please ensure the floor is swept and/or washed on a daily basis.

Three Left Feet arrives on-site early and leaves the school late. Please ensure that the before-/after-school programs are not in the gym for the duration of the residency.

2. An empty AV cart and a table for our use during the residency

3. An easily accessible storage space for our sound equipment, which is available to us for the entire program.

4. Teacher support organizing classes at the Celebration, for rehearsals and daily during the workshops.

5. Workspace

When Three Left Feet is not working directly with your students, we are conducting various administrative tasks during our TLF Meetings (see schedule), recesses and lunch breaks. We conduct business on the road and in schools, and if a quiet workspace with a phone could be available to us, we would be most appreciative.

For the Celebration:

6. Please ensure the gym is not rented during the 2 evenings prior to our Celebration (the last day of the residency).

We set up our "stage" two days prior to the event, and need to leave it intact overnight.

7. Chairs for invited guests.

We recommend that chairs be set up at the same time that we set up our "stage". We provide direction as to where the chairs should go, but we ask that the school be responsible for their actual placement.
